### Inversion in Conditional Clauses Teacher's Copy

1. Had I finished my homework, I would have called you.  
If I had finished my homework, I would have called you
2. Should you happen to see my wife, tell her I called.  
If you should happen to see my wife, tell her I called
3. Were he really a good teacher, he would let us go early.  
If he were really a good teacher, he would let us go early.
4. Were I you I wouldn't do that.  
If I were you, I wouldn't do that.
5. Had I known, I would have told you.  
If I had known, I would have told you.
6. Should anyone call, please take a message.  
If anyone should call, please take a message.

**Note:** Inversions in conditionals are used in formal language.
