Rule?	Most words	after e After the verbs ending in '-e', drop the letter '-e'	afterCVC After verbs ending in a consonant-vowel-consonant, double the last letter	afterie After the verbs ending in '-ie', drop the letters '-ie' and add '-y'

**Note 1:** We only double the last letter if the last syllable is stressed. For example, forget > forgetting but open >opening

**Note 2:** One syllable verbs' last letters are usually doubled. However, with verbs ending –w, –x, –y do not double the last letter. For example, show>showing, mix > mixing, say>saying.

**Note 3:** In US English 'travel' is 'traveling'. We do not double the last letter as in UK English.
