

## Future Perfect Tense

#### Why future perfect tense



We use the future perfect tense <u>to express</u> an action to be completed before a <u>certain point in future.</u>

#### How do we form the future perfect tense



I You He	Pos	They will have arrived by high-speed train in two hours.
She It	Neg	They won't have arrived by high-speed train in two hours.
We They	Que	Will they have arrived by high-speed train in two hours?

## Example Sentences

### Important Notes

- A future time expression is necessary to use future perfect tense unless it's given in the context.
  - Tom will have finished his task. (will finish)
- O Don't use future perfect tense in time clauses.
  - When Mary will have swum, she'll be very exhausted. (has swum)
